SAFEGUARDING GOD'S CHILDREN SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 23 NOON-3PM IN PARISH HALL 2

In 2019, The Episcopal Church and The Episcopal Diocese of Kansas implemented an updated list of recommended "best practices" for the safety of clergy, staff, volunteers and participants engaged in ministry within Episcopal parishes. The Safeguarding God's Church program meets the training expectations for individuals engaged in ministry with adults. This includes, but is not limited to, Lay Eucharistic Visitors, Vestry, Special Needs Ministries, Small Group Ministries, etc. An on-site "Safeguarding God's Church" training will be offered for those involved in these ministries, and is open to anyone who would like to know more about The Episcopal Church's policies on safety in ministry with adults. The training is scheduled from Noon to 3pm, but may not take that full amount of time. A light lunch will be provided. For those who need the training, but cannot attend on this date, an on-line training is available that will meet the requirements, though on-site training often includes additional information through discussion and supplemental materials that can be very beneficial. Notes on Notes—

Beth Loeber Elswick, Director of Music Ministry

Our brains love hearing new music, only to recognize or deduce that something sounds familiar. Likewise, we love hearing a familiar hymn set in a new and creative framework. Hymn arrangers study texts, meter, syllables per phrase, rhyme scheme, and chord progressions. They also love the interchangeable nature of some texts and tunes. When I Survey the Wondrous Cross is a versatile lyric. In fact, the tune that I learned as a child, Hamburg, is a different melody than Rockingham, the one in the 1982 Hymnal. I certainly knew the text, When I survey the wondrous cross, but I was introduced to a new melody with a different meter and harmonies. I love both hymn tunes. Hymnody is fun. Did you know our hymnal incudes four different settings of Psalm 23?

The early Pilgrims were glad that the hymn tunes and texts were recyclable. The organist/ harpsichord player only needed to know eleven tunes to be able to accompany the entire 150 Psalms in the Bay Psalm Book, the first book published in North America, Cambridge Massachusetts, in 1640. (How could I not be overjoyed? The first book published was a hymnal, and the organist only needed to know 11 tunes!)


