SOLAR NEWS:



We are entering the time of year when solar energy will operate optimally. Our energy production will dramatically increase with longer daylight hours, a higher sun path, and fewer clouds. Here is a general report on our solar panels:

Since the end of October, the solar panels have generated 39 Megawatt hours of energy, equivalent to reducing CO2 emissions by 60,054lbs or 454 trees being planted. During the billing period from March 15-April 15, our panels provided 8.4 megawatts of energy, and we only needed to draw 2.4 megawatts from Evergy. Our bill for that month was \$1200 less than last year at the same time.
